### **How long have you been a member of Missouri Smallflows Organization?**

I believe I joined somewhere around 2020

### **Why did you join MSO and the Board of Directors?**

I originally volunteered to help by joining the planning committee for the conference. During the meetings we had throughout the year I began to realize and see how much MSO and Tammy do behind the scenes. There's way more that goes into just the every day tasks of running the program than I never realized. They do a lot of great things for the industry and us as installers, and I urge anybody just starting out to get involved, don't wait until you need the CEU credits. Just getting to meet new people and see how things are done differently in other parts of the state can be a huge advantage. I've enjoyed helping out and when I was asked if I was interested in joining the board, I did not hesitate, I would like to help in anyway I can.

### **Where is your company located and why type of wastewater work do you do?**

Peculiar Mo. We are a utility and septic contractor. We install the sewer, water, and electric services on new homes. When the homes are out on acreages where there is no municipal sewer we install Septic systems. In my area most systems are advanced systems due to the poor soil conditions.

Drip irrigation is what we mainly install, sometimes the soil is favorable enough to do a low pressure system.

### **What do you like most about working in the onsite wastewater industry?**

Wastewater is something most people don't think about at all, whether planning for a new home build or moving into an existing home that's on septic. I enjoy talking with new homeowners and educating them on their septic system. I find more often than not most homeowners are eager to learn how their system works, especially on custom built homes.

## MSO Board Member Spotlight Continued- Josh Drew

### **If you could choose anyone as a mentor, who would you choose?**

Honestly, I would choose my dad, my parents divorced when I was two and I didn't get to spend a lot of time with him growing up until I was older. Now running a business and having my own family and living two hours apart, I see him as much as possible, but any extra time that I could get I would take.

### **What's one thing – either industry related or not – you learned in the last month?**

I had an inspector tell me that they make a 60° 4 inch fitting, I looked into it and they actually do just nobody stocks it.

### **What's something about you (a fun fact) that not many people know?**

I love boating, we spend a lot of time at the lake during the summertime. I will buy boats that have bad engines from not being winterized correctly and rebuild them and sell them in my spare time. Sometimes we'll have up to three boats sitting in the shop, waiting to be rebuilt.

### **What do you think of one of the biggest challenges for the onsite wastewater industry today?**

As time goes on technology advances, new ideas based off experience and past installation arise. From what I've seen it's pretty difficult to change or update any of the rules and regulations. It's a pretty big political process which can be challenging to navigate through. One example would be doing away with the perc testing, I would say 99% of people in this industry would agree that a soil morphology is quite a bit better, but we don't have the power to just change those rules, it has to go through a process and be voted on and approved by the powers to be.

### **Tell us about one work site that gave you a big challenge and you had to be innovative to meet your goals.**

We had a home build site last year that was way back up in the woods, up on a pretty steep hill. We had to cut a road into the hillside just to get our equipment in. Between all the rock, steep grade and trees we had to clear it was a pretty difficult job, not to mention the weatherman was wrong and we had a 6 inch rain in the middle of the project. It was one of those jobs from start to finish that you just had to get through, seemed like every day there was a new obstacle that would arise. I'm sure everyone out there has had a job or two like that, that you couldn't wait to be done.



# Legislative Update

MSO has been supporting two bills in the Missouri Legislature to promote two changes. We thank everyone for their support and you can see updates on these at anytime on our website here:

SB 914, sponsored by Senator Kurtis Gregory, ultimately passed the Senate with several people's support. This bill can be referred to a Committee in the House where MSO will be ready to testify in support of it once again.

HB 2395, sponsored by Representative Bill Falkner, is awaiting a date to be put on the Consent Calendar in the House.

In summary, we are urging a statute change to remove percolation testing and require soil morphology evaluations starting in January 2027. In addition, we are encouraging the change to allow Missouri DHSS and contract counties to charge "reasonable fees" for permits. We all know that \$90 doesn't cover the costs of reviewing a permit, visiting for site inspections multiple times and signing off on a permit. We believe that allowing this change will enable more counties to have local staff review permits and reduce turnaround time for permit reviews.

# On-Site Soil Evaluators Needed

On-site installers work with soil every day, and have a good feeling for what works or not for different types of on-site systems. Many of you would make great on-site soil evaluators.

To get licensed, state requirements include 15 hours of university credits in soil science, with 3 of those credits in soil morphology. You then take a written and field test.



Twenty years ago, there were over 70 on-site soil evaluators, but Missouri is now down to 40, with many of those looking at retirement in the next few years. A good soil evaluation is the basis of a well-functioning on-site system, so it is in all of our interests to build a strong force of people who understand both soil and on-site systems.

Missouri Smallflows Organization is working with the University of Missouri and Missouri State University to develop ways that working professionals can more easily access soils classes to meet the requirement of 15 college hours. This includes ideas such as weekend classes, online courses, and combining internships with formal classes. To set this in motion, we need people interested in becoming on-site soil evaluators. So we need to hear from you! You do not need a college degree, but you do need a good background in both soil and the on-site industry.
